



## Family Camp

### Child-Protection Policy 2021

The Jeremiah Project desires a safe environment for all children and youth. To that end, the Jeremiah Project performs background checks on its entire staff that are 18 years and older. Jeremiah Project also requires that each parent and young adult (18 years and older) attending the JP Family Camp complete a background check.

Background checks for each adult should include – at a minimum – the following:

- **State Criminal History**
- **Federal Criminal History**
- **National Criminal Sex Offender Registry (OFAC)**

Families are responsible for all costs associated with performing the aforementioned background checks. We recommend that these background checks be completed through a reputable professional service provider such as the ones suggested below.

#### **Additional Requirements:**

1. Families must provide, **no later than June 15**, a copy of the completed report to the Jeremiah Project. A copy of a background check from a current employer will suffice.
2. Adults must have had a successful background check performed within the last **five years**.

**This form must be signed and submitted within 14 days of submitting your online Family Camp registration. Your Family Camp application will not be processed until this form is returned signed and dated.**
