A new office was created for the Redeemer Renaissance Preschool and After School programs by splitting an existing large office into two sections.

Transition Team Work to Inform the Call Process

As everyone is aware, Pastor Sandy Kessinger served Redeemer Lutheran for 13-1/2 years. With her retirement, our faith community is now in a transition phase. Part of this phase is the invitation to consider who we are and who God is calling us to be. Before we begin searching for a new pastor, we need to gain clarity on our own identity and ministry through the transition process. During this time, we will look at Redeemer's mission statement, welcome statement, history, ministry partners, and level of involvement by members of the congregation. In the coming weeks we will form a transition team to coordinate and guide the congregation through these conversations. The information we uncover will be necessary as we begin work on our ministry site profile, the formal paperwork required by the synod for the call process. Note that the transition team and associated work are separate from the actual call committee which will be convened at a later date.

Please prayerfully consider if you are being called to this work. The skills and gifts needed include a willingness to dig deep, the ability to leave pre-determined ideas at the door, a willingness to engage in prayer and Bible study, the ability to see the forest and the trees, as well as several other attributes. The process to self-nominate will be announced soon!
