Starting the Real Work of Transition Transition Team Self-Nomination Form Deadline November 30

As has been noted for the last two weeks, Council has been working on a process to use to put a transition team in place. This transition team will start the work needed to gain clarity on our own identity and ministry, as we prepare to call a new pastor. The team will guide Redeemer and our members as we look at Redeemer's mission statement, welcome statement, history, ministry partners, and level of involvement by members of the congregation, and determine what God is calling us to in our next phase of ministry.

This transition team and associated work are separate from the actual call committee, which will be convened at a later date. Serving on the transition team does not exclude you from serving on the call committee; in fact, the aim is to have at least some overlap of members serving on both committees to ensure continuity.

The deadline for submission is November 30, with a target orientation meeting for the team on December 8 at 6:30 PM. Council will be conducting rolling reviews so that the team can get started before the new year.
