Construction Project Update

The outdoor phase of our construction project involves the renovation of the playground area and the addition of a columbarium. We sent out RFPs (Request for Proposals) to several area general contractors, including the firm that is currently doing our interior building renovations. Unfortunately, the bids have come back much higher than we were expecting. The construction budget for the outdoor work was based on two rounds of estimates done during the design phase from an independent estimator. However, additional county requirements for stormwater management and tree protections and annual rising costs have led to this situation. We are currently working with our architects, engineers, and the general contractors to determine how we can reduce these costs and plan for a path forward.
