### Guatemala

Frank and Linda Peterson have gone to Guatemala in the wake of Fuego volcano's recent, massive eruption that took the lives of over 75 people, destroyed villages and injured hundreds.

Immediate needs (food, shelter) appear to be taken care of but there are long term needs that must be met. At least 46 people have been severely burned, many of them children. Partner for Surgery has long worked with the gifted burn surgeon, Dr. Lourdes Santizo, who volunteers her skills. She has taken on many of these burned patients but desperately needs post operative supplies for the long post operative treatment these patients must have to recover.
