Lutheran Social Services Refugee Program

We are pleased to update you all that we have been notified of our family assignment for the LSS Good Neighbor Program. Over the next six months, the Social Concerns Ministry at Redeemer will assist a refugee family from Eritrea as they settle here in Northern Virginia.

The family consists of two siblings, a young man and his sister, in their early twenties and thirties, along with the 4 year old daughter of the sister. Currently all three are living with numerous individuals in one home, but are working with LSS to find a home of their own. Furniture and household supplies will be needed in the future when the family is properly settled.

The young man is a paraplegic which creates additional challenges for the family. He is in need of a hospital bed and motorized wheel chair as well as medical supplies. Redeemer has offered to help with transportation for the young man to attend medical appointments and for the sister to go to job interviews.

We will soon post a list of needed furniture, household items and medical supplies for the family. Your donations and financial support are always welcome. Guatemala

Frank and Linda Peterson have gone to Guatemala in the wake of Fuego volcano's recent, massive eruption that took the lives of over 75 people, destroyed villages and injured hundreds.

Immediate needs (food, shelter) appear to be taken care of but there are long term needs that must be met. At least 46 people have been severely burned, many of them children. Partner for Surgery has long worked with the gifted burn surgeon, Dr. Lourdes Santizo, who volunteers her skills. She has taken on many of these burned patients but desperately needs post operative supplies for the long post operative treatment these patients must have to recover.
