Fuego Volcano Eruption: Partner for Surgery says Thank You, Redeemer!

As many of you know, Guatemala’s Fuego volcano suddenly erupted in June and sent hot lava into numerous villages. Hundreds were killed and many more are still missing. Among the survivors were many burned children, and Partner for Surgery immediately sent out an appeal for funds to help in their post-operative recovery. The generous response of Redeemer and others allowed us to give a \$5,000 check to Dr. Lourdes Santiso, the burn surgeon who has collaborated with us for many years at the Children’s Burn Clinic in Guatemala City.

Help is Needed

Temple Rodef Shalom has asked Redeemer to help them on two important days – September 10 (Rosh Hashanah) and September 19 (Yom Kippur). Our gym will be the location for their worship overflow. On both days the worship will be from 9:30 am until 11:00 am. They expect 300 worshippers.

Pastor is asking for 8-10 volunteers for each day. We will need to be present in the parking lots to help with the flow of traffic. We will need to be at our entrances to open the doors for our guests and to help them find their place of worship. There will be marked entry and exit points in order to keep the disruption to our Preschool ministry at a minimum. All volunteers will need to be present throughout the service so that at the end people can quickly and easily return to their vehicles.

Pastor is asking for the volunteers to be present from 8:45 am until 11:45 am.
