## Congratulations to Deacon Erin

Since May 1, Deacon Erin has been working diligently to complete her internship and seminary course work to be ordained as an ELCA pastor. Based on her review with the synod Candidacy Committee she has successfully completed what was required for internship. Within the coming week she will finish her course work. On December 5 the synod Candidacy Committee met with Deacon Erin and formally approved her to become a Minister of Word and Sacrament (pastor).

What does this mean? The next step is for the ELCA to formally assign Deacon Erin to our region and synod. Once we are notified that this has taken place our council will meet and interview Deacon Erin (as early as January) and then if all goes well the council will recommend to the congregation that we call her as our Associate Pastor (as early as February). Since there is a change in her status (from deacon to pastor) this is required. A Call Vote Sunday will be set at which time the congregation will vote whether or not to call Deacon Erin.

We will continue to keep everyone informed of the next steps and the choices we have moving forward. If you have any questions about the process please do not hesitate to be in touch with Matthew Kratz, our Council President, or Pastor Kessinger.

## Year End Financial Picture

We at Redeemer try to be faithful in our stewardship as demonstrated through our offerings of our time, talent, and treasure. As we have experienced in the past, we now are at the end of our fiscal year and Redeemer faces a shortfall between what we have spent and the total contributions received to date. As an update to the recent letter from our Council President, Matthew Kratz, about this deficit, we have reduced our projected year end operating shortfall from **\$223,858 to \$172,218**. Each and every gift is important and together we can end the year on a positive note. We have done it before and we hope we can do it again this year. Thank you for all that you do to support Redeemer and our mission together.


