New Mortgage Opportunity for Questions Today in Crossroads

The Council has selected the ELCA's Mission Investment Fund to provide the new mortgage for the completion of our upcoming construction project. The \$1.6M loan will be fully amortized over a 25 year term with no balloon payment due. The rate will be approximately 7.375% (final rate is set just prior to closing) and will adjust every 5 years over the life of the loan. The monthly principal and interest payments will be approximately \$11,700. There are no penalties involved with paying off the loan early, as we have done in the past. While the congregation already approved taking on a \$1.6M mortgage at the last annual meeting, there does need to be congregational approval on the selection of the ELCA's Mission Investment Fund and the loan terms. This vote will take place at an upcoming special congregational meeting (date yet to be finalized). In the meantime, there is an opportunity for questions and discussion on mortgage TODAY in the small meeting room off the Crossroads lobby (on the side by the coffee station) following each worship service.
