# New Mortgage Opportunity for Questions Today in Crossroads

The Council has selected the ELCA's Mission Investment Fund to provide the new mortgage for the completion of our upcoming construction project. The \$1.6M loan will be fully amortized over a 25-year term with no balloon payment due. The rate will be approximately 7.375% (final rate is set just prior to closing) and will adjust every 5 years over the life of the loan. The monthly principal and interest payments will be approximately \$11,700. There are no penalties involved with paying off the loan early, as we have done in the past. While the congregation already approved taking on a \$1.6M mortgage at the last annual meeting, there does need to be congregational approval on the selection of the ELCA's Mission Investment Fund and the loan terms. This vote will take place at an upcoming special congregational meeting (date yet to be finalized). In the meantime, there is an opportunity for questions and discussion on mortgage TODAY in the small meeting room off the Crossroads lobby (on the side by the coffee station) following each worship service. # Volunteer Coordinator Needed for Social Outreach Ministry Team

Redeemer's Social Outreach Ministry Team supports the congregation's response to both ongoing and sudden needs of various groups serving others within Redeemer, in the local community, and beyond.

The ministry team distributes financial contributions from Redeemer's annual budget and sponsors the collection of donated items (e.g., school supplies, grocery gift cards, items for Share's food pantry) during the year for specific groups. Some members of the ministry team organize activities within Redeemer (e.g., prayer shawl group, quilting group, Little Food Pantry) and other members are liaisons to groups in the community.
