A memorial service for Jim Ahlgren will be held at Redeemer Lutheran Church on Saturday, August 16, at 11 am.

Presiding Bishop of ELCA Elected Bishop Yehiel Curry

On July 30, Rev. Yehiel Curry was elected at the Churchwide Assembly to serve a six-year term. He is the first Black presiding bishop of the ELCA. Rev. Curry has served as bishop of the ELCA Metropolitan Chicago Synod since 2019. He will be installed as presiding bishop on October 4 at Central Lutheran Church in Minneapolis.

New Mortgage Congregational Meeting for Vote – August 24

The Council has selected the ELCA's Mission Investment Fund to provide the new mortgage for the completion of our upcoming construction project. The \$1.6M loan will be fully amortized over a 25-year term with no balloon payment due. The rate will be approximately 7.375% (final rate is set just prior to closing) and will adjust each 5 years over the life of the loan. The monthly principal and interest payments will be approximately \$11,700. There are no penalties involved with paying off the loan early, as we have done in the past. The loan may also be refinanced to a shorter term when appropriate. While the congregation already approved taking on a \$1.6M mortagage at the last Annual Meeting, there does need to be congregational approval on the selection of the ELCA's Mission Investment Fund and the loan terms. This vote will take place at a special congregational meeting on August 24th, which is being announced today. In the meantime, if there are questions, you can speak to a council representative or email your question to church@redeemermclean.org.

Construction Project Update

On August 18, construction will start in the education wing. The Conference Room set-up will be moved into Music Suite A and the classrooms will be closed. The items in the sacristy have already been moved into the Robe Room. In December, when the first phase of construction is expected to be finished, the office wing will then be closed and the pastor and the staff will be working out of the renovated classrooms temporarily. Once the office wing construction is finished, the staff will move back into their renovated offices. This second phase of construction will also include the renovation of the bathrooms by the office entrance. Signs will be posted to direct people through the location changes.
