# **Construction Project Update**

Ceiling tiles are now being removed in the old classroom wing so that new pipes and electrical wires can be installed for the new HVAC system. The old boiler has been taken offline and those pipes and wall radiators are being removed too. Also, the new rooftop HVAC control units will be put into place soon. There will be one on each side of the building and each room will now be able to control its own temperature, a function not available with the old boiler system.

# **Temple Talk – Endowment Ministry**

The Endowment Fund and Committee were formed in 1995 to extend Redeemer's outreach mission. All donations remain in the Fund; only earnings are dispersed as modest grants to nonprofit organizations, either local or outside our local area.

The latest Endowment Committee grant of \$4000 was approved by Council for the YouthWorks Kingdom Fund in conjunction with the youth mission trip to Niagara Falls in June 2025. Today, representatives from the youth mission trip will speak about their time supporting worthy organizations in the Niagara community.
