



Request for Criminal Records Check

To Applicant:

For the safety of everyone at Camp, it is required by law that all our personnel and volunteers undergo a Criminal Records Check. It is a simple process, and usually involves no cost for your **volunteer position**.

Please complete the following steps to ensure your application can be processed quickly:

1. Visit your local RCMP branch with this letter, and request the necessary forms.
2. Complete all the forms for the Records Check.
 - a. Do not sign these forms until the day you submit them to the RCMP.*
3. Bring photo ID and forms to the RCMP detachment, and ask them to begin the check.
4. Have the RCMP personnel look over your forms to make sure you've completed all the necessary fields.
5. After the allotted time, collect your completed record check, and submit it to Camp.

*At some detachments, forms must be signed only on the day they are received by the RCMP. If you are under the legal age, you may be required to have a parent/guardian come with you to also sign the forms.
