## Mission & Safety

Woodland exists to provide opportunities for Christian growth in a natural setting. In order to fulfill our mission, we host summer camp programs for young people and provide retreat facilities for churches, ministries and non profit groups; we also host and/or lead leadership training programs for the larger community, where Christian principles are taught and/or modeled. Woodland was established in 1969 as a non-profit ministry of Christian Camping. The legacy of Woodland's leaders cast a vision of excellence in facilities and programming. From that beginning, Woodland has grown into a multifaceted ministry, four camps, a challenge ropes course, and popular retreat facility. Woodland seeks to provide maximum safety through supervision and our Child Protection System.

## Activities

Campers will enjoy a variety of activities including the Zip Line, Giant Swing, Pedal Karts, Slip-n-Slide, Canoes/Kayaks/Paddle Boats, Ropes Course, Elementary Obstacle Course, Climbing Tower, Swimming, Putt-Putt Golf, Archery, Fishing, Hiking, Human Foosball, Gaga Ball, Poly Pong, Indoor Climbing Wall, Worship, Campfire, Bible Study, Frisbee Golf, Sports, Inflatable Slide, Carpetball, Playgrounds, etc. Activities are based on grade level and are chosen by the Program Director, so camps may not participate in all activities listed.

## COVID-19 Update:

As of February 2021, no guidance has been issued by Gov. Kemp or GA Department of Public Health in regards to Summer Camp operation. We ARE planning to move forward with our summer programs, but we know things may look a little different. The fall/winter Retreat season has gone very well and we continue to work closely with the local health department on our operating protocols. Once Summer Camp guidance is released, we will plan accordingly and communicate all detailed information to parents.

The safety of our campers, guests, and staff is always at the forefront of our operation. However, we understand that it's difficult to plan for the future and uncertainty remains. If you register for camp, but wish to cancel for COVID-related reasons (including quarantine, fear of exposure, positive COVID test, etc.), you will have the opportunity to receive a full refund. If Woodland has to cancel a program for reasons surrounding COVID, you will be refunded in-full.

We are planning to open Summer Camp Registration on MARCH 1st! Initially, our Summer Camp capacities will be limited to 50%, so we encourage you to register early. Once we receive full guidance from state/local authorities, we hope to increase capacity, but this is not guaranteed. Again, we will be updating you as information becomes available.
