Over the past six years, more than 29,614 children have been rescued from poverty thanks to Wolf's efforts.

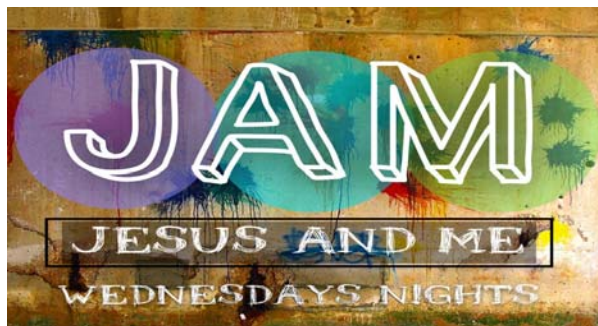
