We are very excited for all of these wonderful people to have a great school year- for the teachers and administrators to be able to impart knowledge and for the children to learn and make great friends and memories.



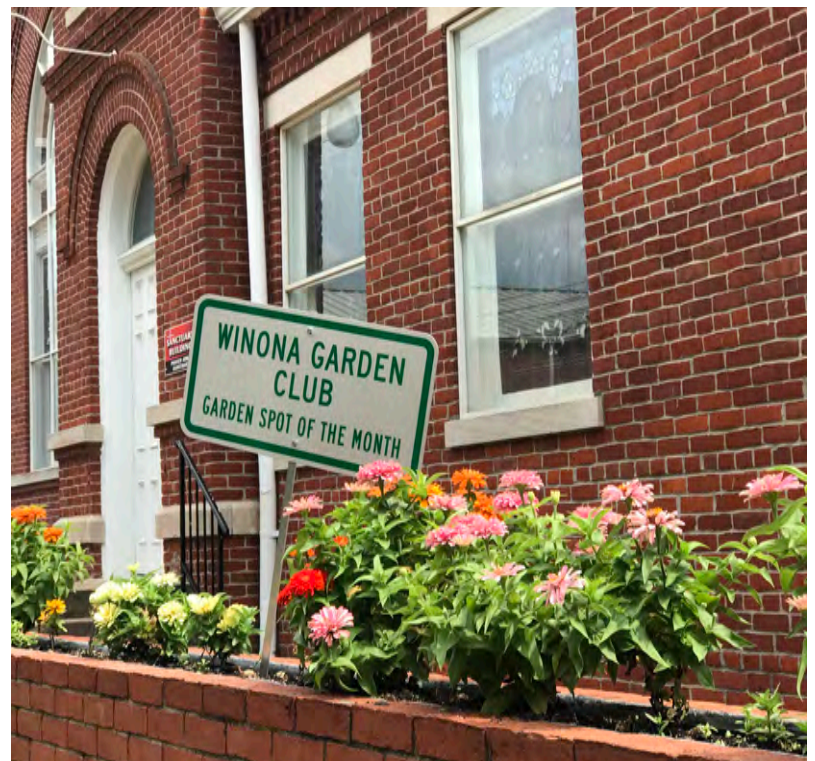
September is full of fun at Moore Memorial!

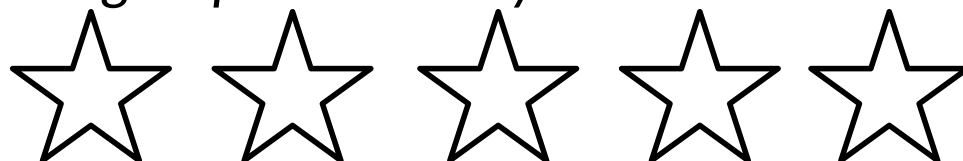
Michelle Pham is a new member of Junior Auxiliary in Winona and has been taking part in projects benefiting the children of Carroll and Montgomery county.

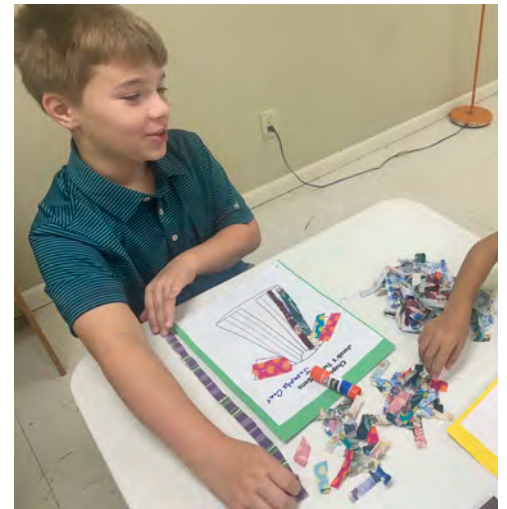

Letter from the Pastor

Good morning!

The other day I was looking at a small needlepoint that we've had for many years now. It's quite simple with an image of a house and a little saying that goes like this: "Home is where the Army sends you."

And as I thought about that I was reminded that I've lived in 26 different houses/parsonages at this point in my life. We've owned them, rented them, been provided them. Some had central heat and air, others didn't. I've attended church in more buildings, chapels, tents, and places than I can count; even on the back deck of a tank or two. Do I miss all those places? 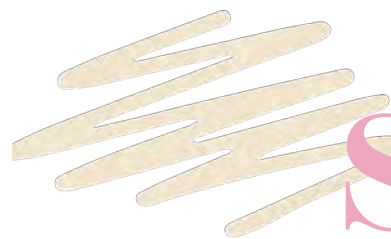
