





Good morning!


The other day I was looking at a small needlepoint that we've had for many years now. It's quite simple with an image of a house and a little saying that goes like this: "Home is where the Army sends you."

And as I thought about that I was reminded that I've lived in 26 different houses/parsonages at this point in my life. We've owned them, rented them, been provided them. 
I'm looking forward to that place, not all those that are behind me. How about you?




