February 15 Altar Flowers





## Letter from the Pastor

I don't know about you, but there are some books that I periodically pull down off my bookshelf and reread. One of them is Great Expectations by Charles Dickens. A couple of years ago now in a conversation with my oldest granddaughter Mabrie she confessed that she "hated Dickens." Some of you may agree with her disdain, but I soon found myself pulling it off the shelf.

As Pip told of his apprenticeship to Joe he said, "all the merit of what I proceed to add was Joe's. It was not because I was faithful, but because Joe was faithful...it was not because I had a strong sense of the virtue of industry, but because Joe (did)...I know right well that any good that intermixed itself with my apprenticeship came of plain contented Joe, and not of restlessly aspiring discontented me."

Discontented me. Oh, how those words seem to describe so many of us in America today. We are discontented with our political leaders and the economy, our jobs, where others are going on vacation, or any of a hundred other things. It's easy to become discontented with life, isn't it? Any good that we do as apprentices likewise comes thru Him.

As we read in Timothy 6:6-8, "godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. And having food and raiment let us be therewith content." Remember, Jesus said, "I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you." May we each recognize the true source of contentment today and every day.


