



Why is the cross draped in red?

Just like you notice the colors change in the Sanctuary for different Sunday services, you also notice when the cross changes colors—particularly during the Easter season.

However, you may not exactly know why (and that is ok!)

If you have ever wondered why we drape the cross in red:

- Red symbolizes the blood of Christ, representing sacrifice and redemption.
- It reflects the passion and suffering of Jesus during His crucifixion.
- The color is often used during Holy Week, particularly on Good Friday.
- Draping the cross in red serves as a visual reminder of the gravity of sin and the cost of salvation.
- It invites reflection and reverence during the liturgical observance.



Easter Lily Programs

There will be several Easter Lily programs in the Sanctuary on Sunday. They can be found in the windowsills in Sanctuary behind computer, in the entryway windowsill and on the table in the entryway. Ask one of the ushers if you are in need of a program showcasing the lilies bought in memory/honor of a loved one.

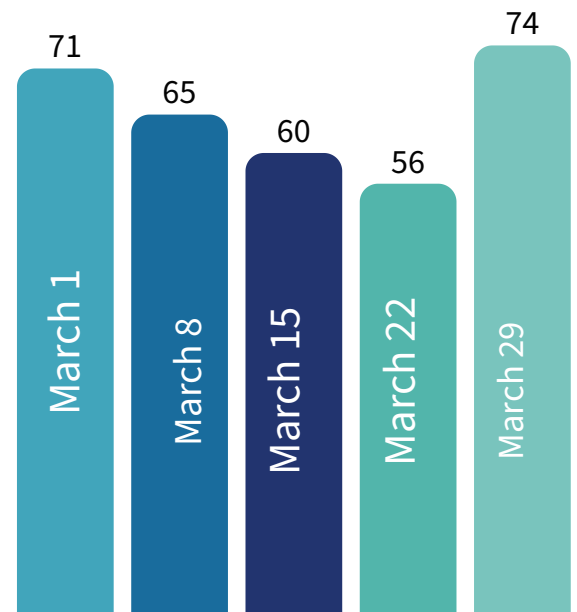

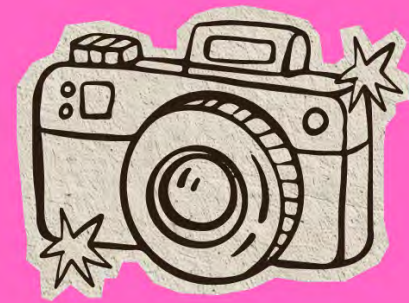

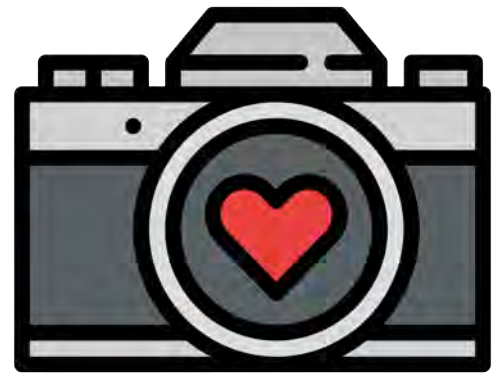

Letter from the Pastor

A couple of weeks ago I found myself in the middle of a storm on I-55. Lighting was popping all around, the rain was coming down harder and harder, I was slowing down more and more when I suddenly realized I couldn't see any lines on the highway. About that time a line appeared and I had drifted off to the left side and was just about to go off the road. After that scare I pulled off to the "right" side instead of pushing on through. I also said a little prayer of thanks!

But we can be like that can't we? Push on in the midst of adversity. It's so easy to fall into the trap of trying to solve everything on our own.
