113 meals were delivered to people in the community!









Letter from the Pastor

Waiting is hard.

Most of the time we have the ability to get whatever we want or need in an extremely quick and easy way. Drive-thrus, overnight delivery, curbside pick-up. Due to this convenience, we have become extremely impatient. As we find ourselves in the midst of the hustle and bustle of this holiday season patience seems to be one of the first things to go. Yet, as we go through the Advent season worshiping and preparing for the arrival of the baby in the manger, patience is one of the key aspects needed to fully embrace and live out this countercultural movement.

Matthew 1, verses 22 thru 25 reminds us that it took over 500 years of patiently waiting for the coming of Emmanuel to break into space and time, so that God could be with us and, ultimately, save us.

Now all of this took place so that what the Lord had spoken through the prophet would be fulfilled: Look! A virgin will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they will call him, Emmanuel. (Emmanuel means "God with us.") When Joseph woke up, he did just as an angel from God commanded and took Mary as his wife. But he didn't have sexual relations with her until she gave birth to a son. Joseph called him Jesus. -- Matthew 1:22-25


