

Governance

Grace Christian Community is governed by the members of the church. The day to day administration of the association is done by the Administration Committee. This committee are elected from within, by the members of the church at a general meeting.

The Administration Committee:

- A. is authorised and has responsibility to determine and administer the financial affairs of the association, including the setting of an annual budget, and
- B. is authorised and has responsibility to manage the property of the association, and
- C. is authorised and has responsibility to perform all such acts and do all such things as deemed to be necessary or desirable for the proper management of the affairs of the association.

Further to this, an external board known as the Board of Reference exists to provide accountability and support to the congregation (see Board of Reference Document). They are made up of experienced Christian ministers who support the ministry of Grace Christian Community. They are available for consultation, mediation, and support for the ministry of the church.

The church bank accounts can only be accessed by two authorised signatories chosen by the Administration Committee. The Administration Committee are to provide the members of the church with relevant financial reports and the annual budget for reception.
