Be Intentional: Know and Do God's Will

Sunday Questions:

1. Do you tend to think of "God's will" as being about your own life or about bigger things, like your family, your community, or the world?
2. How might your gifts fit into what God is doing in your neighborhood, your family, and your church?

Everyone should come with something written down! These questions do not need to be asked in group directly, but if someone is quiet, feel free to ask, "What did you put down for..."

Growth Group Questions

1. Do you use a GPS navigation system? On long trips only or around town too?
2. Do you tend to think of "God's will" as being about your own life or about bigger things, like your family, your community, or the world?
3. Read Jeremiah 1:1-8
 - a. Note for a minute how very specific it is about time, place, and person
 - b. To what extent is this about God's will for Jeremiah and to what extent is it about God's larger project in which Jeremiah is to play a role?
 - c. What does verse 8 imply about whether this will be easy or hard?
4. One of Jeremiah's objections is that he doesn't have the skills. Pastor Jeff shared the classic phrase, "God doesn't call the equipped, God equips the called." Have you ever experienced this?
5. What do you think God might be doing in your neighborhood? In your family? In your church?
 - a. How might your gifts fit into that?

Pastor Jeff's notes:

v. 1-3 especially

Examples in v. 5 contains both; v. 10 seems to imply God's larger project. What's the balance?

Wait... Rescue? Rescue FROM WHAT???

Jeremiah's objection is in v. 6. God's response is v. 7 and then again in 9.

*This is key!! Please give this serious consideration!
Another classic phrase: Stop saying "God, bless what I am doing" and start saying, "God, help me to be part of what you are blessing!"*
