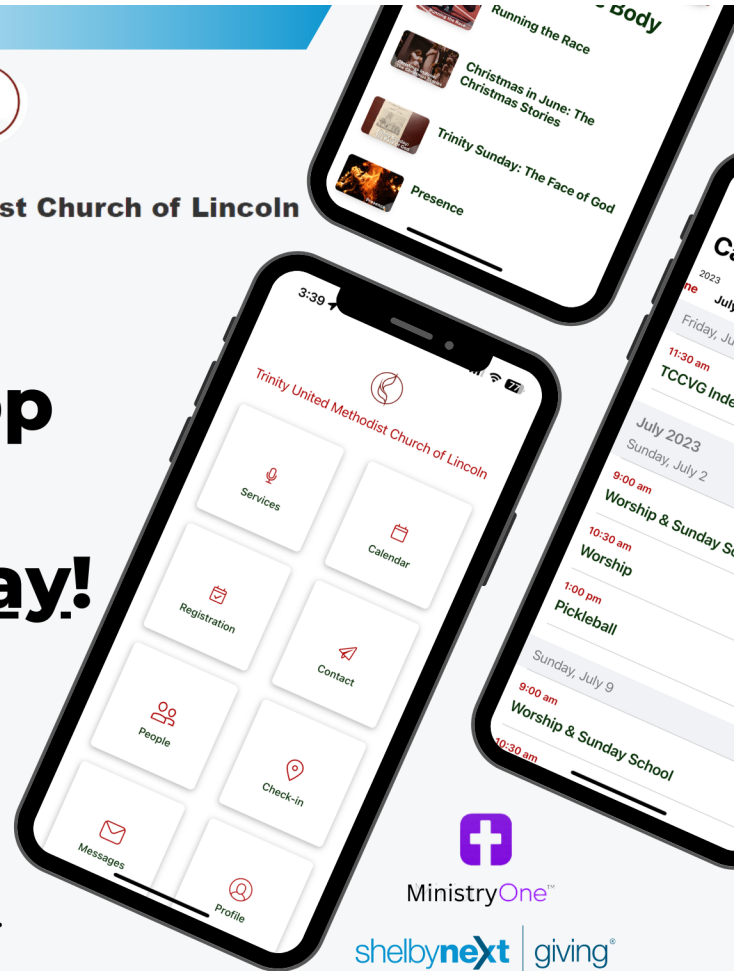

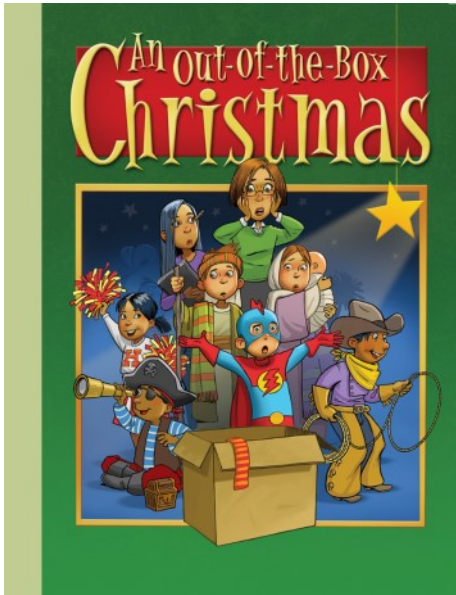

## **Lela Marie Ketchum Cohn**

**January 20, 1931 - July 25, 2023**

Always competitive, she always played to win whether ping pong, gin rummy or any other game where a winner could be declared. She loved to play bridge and made friends whenever she was at a bridge table. After moving to Lincoln in 2020 she discovered the shuffleboard table and attacked it with the same gusto. Lela was guided by her faith, a Methodist her entire life, she was a faithful volunteer at her church whenever and however needed. Her love, graciousness, kindness and compassion were felt by so many.

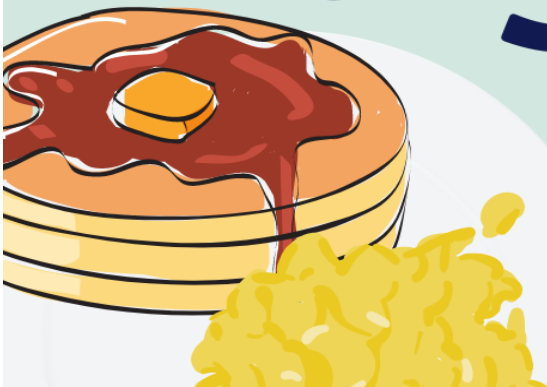
