

After a long wait, we finally have a refugee family to sponsor and welcome to Lincoln! The family-Husband, Wife, four children, and 5 nieces and nephews-have arrived in Lincoln this week; the kids consist of 4 boys: 10, 9, 3, and 2 years and 5 girls: 16, 7, 6,5, and 1 year 10 months. The Refugee Team is working hard to get a home set up and ready for the family to move in next week. Because of the size of the family, we have some needs that were not expected and some that could not be met until we knew who and how many were coming.

If all of this seems like a short notice, it is!! We were advised of the family of 11 earlier this week and are rushing to do what we can to cover their needs. 
