#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 cup Butter, melted
- cup Granulated sugar
- 1 cup Brown sugar
- 2 Eggs
- 1 tsp Vanilla extract
- 2 cups Flour
- 1 tsp Cinnamon
- 1 tsp Baking soda
- tsp Baking powder
- 2 cups Terri Lynn Fancy Pecan Pieces 1 cup Toffee Bits

# BUTTER PECAN COOKIES DIRECTIONS

- In a large mixing bowl, cream together butter, granulated sugar and brown sugar until light and fluffy.
- Add eggs, vanilla extract and mix until smooth.
- Add flour, cinnamon, baking soda, baking powder and mix until just combined.
- Mix in pecans and toffee bits until evenly distributed.
- Chill dough for 30 minutes.
- Scoop out small portions of the dough on cookie sheet.
- Bake at 350 degrees F for about 11-14 minutes.





## PECAN CRUSTED SALMON

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 4 6oz sized pieces of Salmon
- 2 cups Milk
- 1 cup Terri Lynn Fancy Pecan Pieces (finely chopped)
- ½ cup Flour
- ¼ cup Brown sugar
- 1 tsp Salt
- 1 tsp Pepper Vegetable oil

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- Put salmon and milk in a Ziploc bag for 10 min. Take out salmon and discard milk.
- Combine all dry ingredients in a bowl. Completely coat salmon in dry mixture.
- Place oil in a frying pan on med-high heat. Brown both sides (about 2-3 min each side). Place salmon on a cookie sheet lined with non-stick cooking spray and bake at 400 degrees for 8 to 10 min.

She earned her Masters in teaching at UNO in 1972.

In 1976, she retired from teaching to stay at home with her son and wanted to focus on her family and watch her children grow up.

She was actively involved with the school and extracurricular activities her two sons participated in. After the death of her husband in 2014, she moved to Lincoln to be closer to her sons.

Peggy loved to cross stitch and loved attending the annual quilt auction at Camp Fontanelle. She loved giving meaningful gifts to her friends, traveling, and taking day trips with friends.

Peggy leaves behind her beloved children Ryan and Ross (Jamie), Brothers Rod (Esther), and Larry (Ruth Ann), along with plenty of nieces, nephews, cousins, and a multitude of family friends.

Peggy has been living with pain for a long time, and she can now be free of that pain and reunite with her husband, Elmer in the life that comes after alongside Jesus, her savior. Peggy will fill our hearts always as we continue to honor her memories and celebrate her legacy.

A Celebration of Life will occur at Trinity United Methodist Church in Lincoln, NE, on Sunday, November 26th at 2 p.m. This will allow extended family members and friends to have an opportunity to attend the service and provide for the children to attend the services.
