






From the Pastor's Desk

Last Sunday we examined 2 Peter 3:10-12 and considered the end of times or "the day of the Lord" that is yet to come. Since I went a few minutes long, I'll attempt to give it back to you this morning, as we consider only one verse!

God is faithful. You can count on Him. He always tempers darkness with light. Jesus brought light into this dark world, proclaimed Himself to be the light of the world, and then called His disciples to let their light shine so that all would see it and give thanks to the Father! He brought good news into a world filled with bad news, He brought good news for troubled people. The verses we looked at last Sunday (3:10-12) reveal a dark picture of a world where everything people strive to possess is going to be destroyed in that last day. God's offers another option in verse 13 which says, "But according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells."

After describing the horrors of "the day of the Lord" verse 13 begins with the word "But" – the KJV begins with the word "Nevertheless" – meaning God's option is now being revealed. Some people read Peter's letter and never get past those dark verses we read last week; but blessings await those who will take the long look and see beyond to what God holds in store! Petr wanted his readers to know that . . .

...We find joy after the judgment! (3:10-13a) Don't be swayed by the foolishness of this world, the Lord is coming in judgment, but He will come unexpectedly! The world will be consumed in the last day, but still, this is not the end! For those who belong to the Lord, there are better days ahead "according to His promise!" This is a statement of sweet anticipation – not a moment of dreaded arrival! You see, . . .

...God's delight will follow the dissolving! (3:13b) Everything will be changed in that day. The possessions of this life will be gone – along with the problems, difficulties, and struggles they bring. All the accumulated wealth of the wicked will dissolve away and all they've gained will be gone in an instant! Instead of all we've known before, a new age will be ushered in with presentation of the "new heavens and (a) new earth" (13b). You see, God's promises of "eternal life" are true and will be brought to fulfillment in that day. A "new heaven and a new earth" where there will be no tears, death, mourning, crying, or pain -- all the old things that made life miserable are gone and everything is made new! Peter is telling us . . .

...Righteousness will come ... after the ruin! (3:13c) Our mighty God can create, destroy, and create again. After the destruction Peter writes of, when God creates all things new — He who is "righteousness" will dwell forever with His people. This will fulfill many of His promises. How glorious!

We are all sinners but still God loves us! We deserve nothing but destruction and hell, but He promises life and heaven to those who come to Him through faith in Jesus Christ! God's grace is sufficient to carry us and keep us until we arrive at this new place of rest for His children He has prepared for us. I would encourage you today to call on the Lord; repent, believe, follow Him, and you will . . . Be Blessed!
