# From the Pastor's Desk

This morning, I will sit in my customary seat on the front row, the same place I've sat for the past twenty years but today I will not rise to enter the pulpit and open God's Word for you. This morning, I will remain seated because we have a guest speaker. Cal Hiebsch, a native of Wichita and a missionary with our International Mission Board is our special guest today. He will be sharing God's Word with us even as he informs us about the work he is engaged in. You might wonder, "Why are we going to hear from a foreign missionary?" There are several reasons.

1<sup>st</sup>, as a Southern Baptist Church who willingly and faithfully participates in the Cooperative Program and contributes generously to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering for Foreign Missions, we at Believers Southern Baptist Church are partners with Cal and approximately 3,500 others like him. It is good for us to have the opportunity to put a face and a voice with those whom we support in the Great Commission work of taking and sending the Good News of Jesus Christ all around the world.

2<sup>nd</sup>, we need to be reminded that it takes all of us – those who give and those who go – to make the mission work! I am thankful that there are many who have heard the voice of the LORD saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" and have answered like the prophet, "Here am I. Send Me!" (Is. 6:9). The mission will never be completed without those who hear the call and are willing to go. But it takes more than just someone who is willing to go. Paul questioned the Romans asking them, "How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher? How will they preach unless they are sent?" (Romans 10:14-15). My friends, I will never diminish or discourage someone who feels called to go as a missionary, but you can be certain of this as well, I will never stop encouraging Gods people to gift faithfully and generously to support those who have gone 9:15 AM and need our support! The fulfillment of God's Kingdom mission 10:30 AM requires servants and senders.

3<sup>rd</sup>, as we enter these last two months of 2025 what a wonderful opportunity to find inspiration to pray diligently, dig deeply, and give generously to support the work of OUR MISSIONARIES around the globe. There are so many who have never heard the glorious name of our Savior, they have never been told about a heavenly Father who loved them so much that He was willing to sacrifice His own Son so that they might have life. They have never experienced the life-changing power available through Jesus that can make a world-weary soul into a new creation. Without a willing missionary and faithful sending churches, how many will perish without ever hearing about the hope that is found in Jesus Christ?

None of us know the time of our Lord's return, but with each passing day we are closer. The time is growing shorter. Let's be faithful to give as we are led, to go as we are sent and serve in His kingdom as opportunities are given to us. Are you ready? Are you willing to be used for His purposes today and every day? Is He calling you today? Hear His voice, follow where He leads, and you will . . . Be blessed!
