

From the Pastor's Desk

This is the time of year when we talk as a church, about giving. We present and adopt an operating budget for the new year; we discuss missions and ministries. We identify giving opportunities and needs as Southern Baptists and here at BSBC. We take the Great Commission seriously and believe it's our calling to take and send the Gospel across the globe knowing that our awesome God has given us tools and resources to use in accomplishing our calling.

BSBC participates along with over 50,000 other churches in the Cooperative Program. We set a percentage (9.5%) of our undesignated funds to be forwarded on to our state convention (KNCSB) and they then forward a designated percentage (nearly 30%) on to the Southern Baptist Convention (SBC). These monies are used at each level to support and fund missions and ministries that we are not able to do on our own. In cooperation with other SBC churches, we minister locally and globally, provide theological education for next generation leaders, and provide a presence and voice within the culture of our nation.

Our church also provides a World Missions Offering (WMO) which supports three different mission offerings and you may contribute to this at any time during the year. The Lottie Moon Foreign Missions Offering is for International Missions, and it receives 40% of our WMO dollars (\$11,584.60 last year). The Annie Armstrong Home Missions Offering is for North American mission causes and it receives 30% of our WMO dollars (\$8,004.70 last year). The Viola Webb State Missions Offering for KNCSB mission work also receives 30% of our WMO dollars (\$7,874.70 last year). These offerings allow our church to systematically and regularly support these offerings and individuals may still contribute to any one as they feel led.

Our world is still filled with hungry, hurting, lonely, struggling people who are too often living their lives in quiet desperation. There are real struggles with physical, economic, and relational issues in our culture, but I still believe the greatest issue we have is that of spiritual lostness. We are all sinners – every one of us, without exception. For those who have found cleansing and forgiveness in Jesus Christ life looks different than it does for those who are still lost in their sin.

That is why we are still here and sharing the gospel and that will not change as long as the Lord blesses us with the opportunity! I know many are concerned about things we don't have now that we've had in the past; the world is changing, and we must be constantly looking for new ways to engage our culture with the Good News. We must always be prepared to re-think the way we do things! Meanwhile, we will still live out Acts 1:8 and the Master's plan; "you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

Times are hard and they may get harder still, but this is not the time to give up! The world population has now reached 8.2 billion and grows by almost 1.5 million *every week*; with 3,171 identified people groups that are unreached and unengaged with the gospel, this is no time to back down! Every day approximately 155,000 people enter eternity without Christ. This is the time to step up and seize the challenge to go, give, and send ... so all may hear that Jesus saves!

We have little humans running around our house. They are loud, energetic, and constantly moving. Most days I wonder if I'm going to have the energy to keep up in a couple years (or really the next day). Our current youngest is now talking all the time, although most of the time I have no idea what she is saying, and is learning new words every day. One of the words she learned pretty early was "Thank you." I think this is one of the first words parents try to teach to their kids.

If she wants anything or is helped with anything (which at this stage is a lot), we expect her to say "thank you," and if she doesn't we tell her to say it. As kids get older and start learning more words and eventually don't need as much help with things, we tend to start easing up on making them say "thank you." It's not because we don't want them to be thankful, but more so because we get lazy, get tired of saying it, or just think they know it.

Similarly, we could say a lot of the same things about being thankful to God. When we first begin our relationship with Him, we are thankful for everything. We realize how much sin we have in our lives, how wicked we really are, and how much God sacrificed for us to be saved from our sin. To show our thanks, we read the Bible, pray, tell others about our decision to follow Him, and serve where we can.

As we get older and further away from that first moment of God saving us, we stop being as thankful. We're not as excited to pray and read our Bible, we don't look forward to going to church anymore, it seems like more of a chore to serve, and we don't tell anyone else about Jesus because we don't want to be an inconvenience.

But what do you think this mindset teaches to your children and other young people around you? They will not learn about God from what you believe. They will not learn to sacrifice for God when they don't see you taking the time to read the Bible. Your kids will learn that God is just another thing in life if we continue down this path. Your kids need to see you daily living out what you say you believe. They need to see you reading your Bible. They need to see you serving others sacrificially. They need to see you sharing your faith with someone else.

Let's live a life of thankfulness to God.

Let's live like we actually believe what we say we believe. Let's let every part of our lives, through our thoughts, words, and actions, be a living sacrifice of thankfulness to Him.
