
It's Angel Tree Time!





From the Pastor's Desk

This morning, Brother Andrew will be preaching in my absence, but I still wanted to remind you that today, all over the world churches will begin the celebration of Advent. The arrival of Messiah, Immanuel, our Redeemer, was and is an event worthy of celebration! Before His coming, the world was a dark place; life was hard...especially for Israel, God's chosen people, who always seemed to face adversity. Their history was a story of struggle. They gloried in the light of God or floundered in the darkness of His seeming absence. The prophet Isaiah promised a coming Messiah, a deliverer for God's people saying, "The Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel" (7:14). Immanuel (God With Us!) was a promise that Israel longed for across the years.

Nazareth was an insignificant village in Galilee that wasn't even mentioned in the Old Testament. It rose to prominence only after it was identified as the hometown of Mary and Joseph, and the place where Jesus spent His early years. Located in lower Galilee about halfway between the Sea of Galilee and the Mediterranean Sea, it had only one spring to supply fresh water for its residents. Today that spring is called "Mary's well," and we can imagine Jesus going there to draw water for his family. The Church of the Annunciation stands today over the location where tradition says Mary and Joseph lived. (Source: Holman Bible Dictionary, Broadman & Holman 1991, pp. 1010-1011)

Poverty characterized Nazareth's Jewish population. In the synagogue, they read the Torah and the promise of a coming Messiah. No doubt, Mary had read the predictions of Isaiah many times while growing up. "A virgin shall conceive!" Surely God would choose a young noblewoman from Jerusalem. No matter – just so Messiah came and came quickly, to rescue His people from bondage. "O come, O come, Immanuel!" Surely that was the heart cry of Israel. Each of the three words that comprise the Hebrew translation of <u>Immanuel</u> is significant:

1st is *GOD*; the Creator who brought everything into being out of nothing and then made man in His own image. He made man different than anything else in creation -- God allowed these human beings to choose to love and obey Him or reject Him and go their own way. Yet, when Adam and Eve sinned, God refused to give up on mankind.

2nd is *WITH*; meaning that He is "near to or alongside of" us! One name given the Holy Spirit is *Paraclete*, which means "one who is called alongside another." How comforting to know that in our times of struggle, fear, and doubt God is near to us -- He is in the company of His people.

3rd is *US*; God is with US! Because of His great love He is with us and in the words of Jesus He will be with us till the end of the age.

So, when you read, hear, or see the word Immanuel in the days ahead I urge you to stop and marvel at this glorious truth . . . *God with us!* Is He with you? Do you know Him? What better time to meet Jesus personally than as we celebrate His birth! Come and see, meet and worship Jesus, and you will . . . Be Blessed!
