From the Pastor's Desk

Happy Mother's Day! Today we celebrate Mothers and the importance of Christian parenting. I often hear people say, **"I was raised in a Christian home"** and I've said the same, but there is no Christian home unless the family is led by Christian parents. Sometimes it works perfectly, but sometimes sin changes the equation so that many speak of being raised by **"a Christian mother."** A mother who's a disciple; following, serving, and honoring the Lord as she carries out the ministry the Lord has given her.

This morning, I want us to consider a mother who got together with Jesus to make an amazing difference in the life of her child. We don't know her name; we only know the region she came from, that she was not Jewish, that she loved her child, and she believed Jesus could make the difference she was pursuing. When we enter Matthew 15:21-28, we read that Jesus departed the land of the Jews and had gone **"into the district of Tyre and Sidon"** (21) where He was confronted by **"a Canaanite woman"** (22). In the verses that follow we learn about what happens when a Momma and a Jesus get together! In this passage, we see a meeting between . . .

...Jesus and a troubled mother (15:22). Most mothers constantly think about their children, watching over them, and being troubled when things aren't right with their kids. Mommas are often prayer warriors who constantly call their kids names before the throne of heaven, and they are keenly aware of evil threatening their kids. This woman's daughter suffered from demon-possession and it's likely she had gone everywhere and done everything she could – **without success!** Then she heard Jesus was in the area and she went to Him, believing He could deliver her daughter. She didn't approach Jesus just to see what might happen. No, we see . . .

...Jesus with a mother of faith (15:22, 25, 27). This momma had a deep, abiding love for her daughter that made her keenly aware of the child's condition. She called out to Jesus, **"Have mercy on me, Lord, Son of David; my daughter is cruelly demon-possessed"** (22). Her child's daughter's need was her need; her daughter's suffering was her own – **AND** she acknowledged who Jesus was! She spoke respectfully to this teacher, whom she had never met before as she pleaded for help. She didn't expect much, just the **"crumbs"** that might fall from the **"master's table"** (27). Finally, we see . . .

...What makes a victorious mother (15:21, 28). There are two truths I want to be sure we see – matters of vital importance for every godly parent. 1st, she sought Jesus out (21). Jesus came to this region to get away, not to be found. Her love and faith drove her to go to Jesus and face almost certain prejudice, if it meant finding help. 2nd, she conquered her fear with faith. She endured the scorn of the disciples, the silence of the rabbi, and then being put-off as unworthy. But her humility, faith, and persistence led to the miracle she sought!

Her faith was rewarded, her prayer was heard, and her daughter delivered. Jesus commended this mother's **"great faith"** (28) as He granted her request. We can learn from this account that **"Divine delays"** are not always **denials**. Are you pursuing Jesus today? If not, I beg of you, start now. Pursue Him, surrender to Him, follow Him and you will . . . Be Blessed!

The Virtuous Woman

This example is found in the last portion of the last chapter of Proverbs 31:10-31.

If there ever was a lady that was a multitasker it is the lady described in this passage. She is a businessperson buying land, farms the land, works with her mind and hands and has a true entrepreneurial spirit as she sells her wares. In the midst of doing all these things she puts her husbands and children's needs as priority.

This scripture is almost a dichotomy of the life of Solomon because he could write about the wonderful virtuous woman while himself having 700 wives. It shows the ideal vs his personal reality, but he writes it to his son so that he may have what Solomon with all his wisdom did not. A singular, virtuous woman. In Solomons later writings specifically in Ecclesiastes 7:26-28 he seems to regret not following his own advice in terms of seeking a virtuous woman.

He speaks of his relationship with women in verse 26 as "more bitter than death" and "being trapped by her". In verse 28 in reference to 700 wives and 300 concubines he writes this. "One man among a thousand I have been found, but a woman among all of these I have not found". The "a woman" reference is viewed to refer to the virtuous woman from Proverbs 31:10-31. So that in all the relationships Solomon had he went 0-1,000 in finding a truly virtuous woman.

Today as we celebrate the mothers in our lives, I pray that we as men do our part in the process. No, we cannot choose our mothers, but we can choose godly women in the mold of the virtuous woman to be our wives and mothers to our children.

I am so thankful for the wonderful godly mother that I had and for Janet an amazing wife and mother to our children. I pray that each boy and young man will seek and find this kind of woman for their life partner.

**Her children rise up and call her blessed;
her husband also, and he praises her:
"Many women have done excellently,
but you surpass them all.
"Charm is deceitful, and beauty is vain,
but a woman who fears the LORD
is to be praised.**
