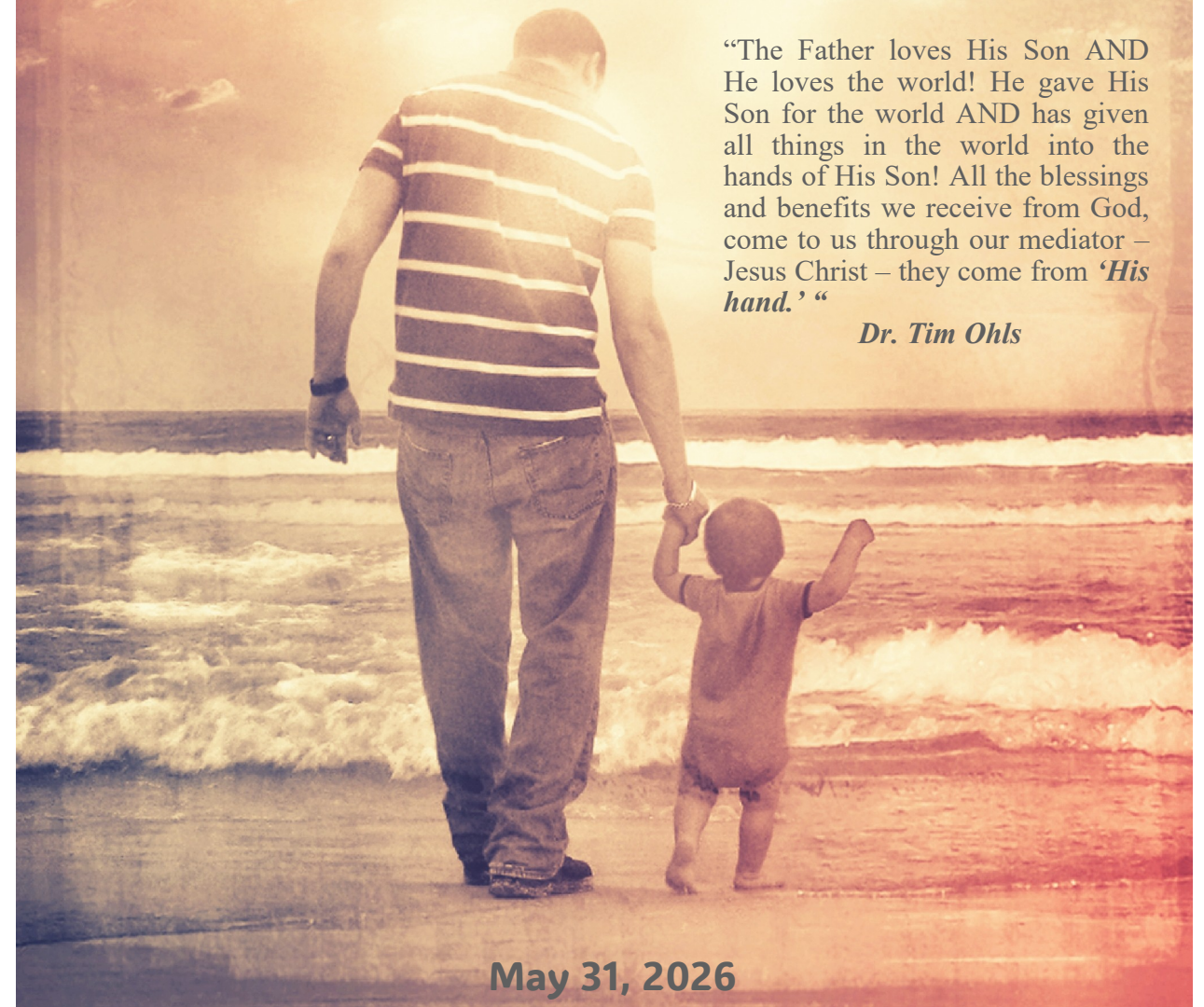

From the Pastor's Pen

Today, we will examine what I believe to be the Baptizer's final testimony. John would continue to preach, challenge sin, and call for repentance; his confrontation of Herod's sinful lifestyle would soon lead to his imprisonment and death.

I was recently telling someone that one of my goals in sermon preparation, is the desire to find at least one "aha moment" in each passage; something fresh, unique, or new. To present an idea that maybe you've never seen or considered. Some texts just don't allow that to happen, and this is one of those! There isn't anything different, unique, or special about John's words. He presents the basic gospel to his disciples concluding with "He who believes in the Son has eternal life." However, John began by explaining . . .

...The message about Messiah (3:31-32). It is vital that we know the difference between God and man and are able to distinguish between the two. John was very clear that Jesus is the One who came from heaven. Jesus "comes from above and is above all." John admitted he was just a man. It's as if he was saying, "He came from heaven! I simply belong to this earth! I've been given a unique ministry opportunity, but He is greater!" How can we possibly understand what Jesus has seen and heard? He came from heaven where He has seen and heard all that the Father has said and done! Because the Father and Jesus are so intimately connected, if you reject Jesus, you also reject God! You cannot have One without the other! John also wanted to be sure his disciples knew that . . .

...Messiah's message is TRUTH! (3:33-34) John wrote that "He who has received His testimony has set his seal to this, that God is true" (33). When you embrace the words of Jesus, you are embracing the heart of God and His desire to provide salvation! Redemption is God's priority! The Holy Spirit empowers the message; He who rested upon Jesus is given "without measure" or with abundance to those who believe. Salvation is the work of the Trinity! To believe in Jesus is to believe in God the Father and receive the ministry of the Holy Spirit into one's life. It's a new and different life, found only in Jesus, because only. . .

...Messiah's message offers life (3:35-36). What an amazing relationship is revealed here. "The Father loves the Son and has given all things into His hand" (35). The Father loves His Son AND He loves the world! He gave His Son for the world AND has given all things in the world into the hands of His Son! All the blessings and benefits we receive from God, come to us through our mediator - Jesus Christ - they come from "His hand." This Father/Son love has provided us with a pathway to eternal life. The summary of John 3 is in verse 36, "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him." Sinful humanity is facing "the wrath of God" today, as it did in that day.

The test of what you really want in life comes when you hear about Jesus. Do you come to the light, or do you continue in darkness? **That is the test.** What would you choose today?

This test is Pass/Fail and there are no re-takes! Believe and you will . . .
