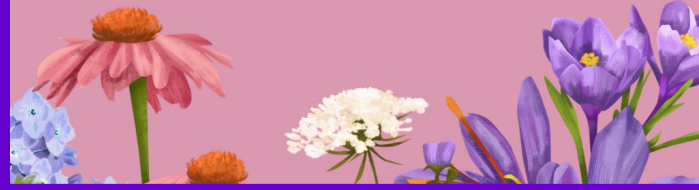

## From the Pastor's Pen

As we gather to worship this morning, things are different in the building! Tomorrow morning, we begin a week of Vacation Bible School, and I'm asking you to pray for our teachers, workers, and the children who will attend. Our goal is for Jesus to be magnified as we teach the TRUTH of God's Word! I love this week and getting to bring children to Jesus.

Today is also Father's Day and as we continue in John's gospel we are going to look at a father who faced a serious problem and went to Jesus to find the answer. As I studied these verses, I realized this man shows us what is required if one is set on "***Finding Success in Fatherhood.***" **To achieve success, we need to . . .**

**...Find Jesus!** (4:46-47). The illness of this man's son set him in motion! News of Jesus had probably been scarce while He was in the region of the Samaritans, but now people were talking again; He'd come home – to Galilee; Jesus was home and He was back in Cana where He had performed His 1<sup>st</sup> miracle. The miracle worker had returned! What great news this was; it was like someone telling Him a miracle cure had been found! I'll never discourage you from seeking physical help when needed; but I want to encourage you to always "**Find Jesus**" and tell Him the needs in your family! Tell Him about your own needs and struggles, as well as the needs of your children! **Let your children see that you . . .**

**...Recognize your limitations and believe in His power!** (4:48-49). Dads, what you do to provide, protect, and care for your family is important, but no matter how good a job you do, there will come a time when it's not enough! You will need help and you'll be forced to call on someone else; this man of wealth and title had to ask Jesus because he couldn't help his own son. Can you hear the tremors of emotion that probably wavered through his voice as he made his request? It would've been so easy to be indignant; But his child's need was greater than his pride – so he persisted in asking. By asking, he learned a lesson about how to . . .

**...Have faith and believe in Jesus!** (4:50-54). It's easy to talk about faith, but having/keeping faith **IS HARD!** **Jesus said to him, "Go; your son lives"** (50) and the man walked away to go home! He left to go see his son and celebrate his recovery – **that's faith!** On the way home he found out that his son was healed at the very time Jesus spoke it into being. Now that's what I call "*a God-thing.*" This Dad "**and all his household believed.**" (53) Never underestimate the value of a father's faith.

**Can you imagine the testimony that his son might share decades later?** Daddy went to find help and found Jesus. Daddy knew he couldn't fix our problems, so he swallowed his pride and asked Jesus to help us in our situation. Daddy had faith and believed Jesus to do what He said He would do ... and **HE DID IT!** **Now Daddy ... and all of us ... are believers in Jesus.**

Church family let's all pray for Jesus to speak through our VBS and be sure we are leading our families to Jesus. Have faith in His power and trust Him for miracles! Go to Him, follow Him and you will . . . Be Blessed!
