From the Pastor's Desk

As we worship this morning, we will be observing the Lord's supper together. Through the years I have been asked some very real, searching questions about the practice of churches as they observe this memorial service together. One question is, *"Is it really that important?"* I think so, because a record of the Lord's Supper is found in four places in Scripture (Matt. 26:26–28; Mark 14:22–26; Luke 22:19–20; 1 Cor. 11:23–24) and Jesus told His followers to *"do this in remembrance"* of Him. As His disciples we need to be obedient and follow His directions. A disciple is one who has counted the cost of following Jesus and chosen to do so. A disciple is one who has been taught and trained by the Master; he or she has come out of the darkness of ignorance, superstition, and sin to live in the light of truth, forgiveness, and grace. Jesus called His disciples to a disciplined lifestyle of self-sacrifice; a life marked by their willingness to suffer for His name's sake and for the benefit of His Kingdom.

Discipleship requires the discipline of conversion (or the new birth). It requires that we acknowledge our rebellion against God (confess) and repent (turn) from our sin that leads us away from our only hope! At the same time, we must recognize Jesus as God's Son who died, paying the price for our sin – as the only Savior and Lord! We have a moment of conversion when we are born again, but we also experience conversion daily as we grow in Christ and Christlikeness. Each day He is changing us, re-making and re-shaping us into His image.

Discipleship also requires the discipline of cost. Becoming a disciple of Jesus is a free gift, but its not cheap! Jesus called His disciples to love Him more than their families – parents, siblings, children – all are important, but the quality and intensity of love we have for God should be superior to anyone/anything else in our lives. Only ONE is qualified to be seated on the throne of our hearts! King Jesus! Finally, . . .

Discipleship requires the discipline of "Cross-Bearing." Jesus said in Luke 9:27 that *"If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross daily and follow Me."* We are not called to bear the cross of Jesus. He bore His cross and died upon it to pay the price for our redemption – we can add nothing to that. It is complete! It's not the bearing of some petty inconvenience or discomfort; we are called to bear the cross of self-denial as we surrender fully to the will of God. The cross is an instrument of death and each day we must deal a "death blow" to self. That is cross bearing. It's not a sad way of living, but rather a life of deep, satisfying joy that is experienced when we place ourselves under the control of God and submit daily to the lordship of Jesus Christ.

Are we experiencing daily the discipline of conversion, and letting God change us, correct us, mold us, perfect us? Have we dealt with the discipline of cost—are we willing to surrender each day so that Christ might inhabit the throne of our heart? Are we engaged in the discipline of cross bearing and becoming more like Jesus every day? Perhaps today, He is calling you, do you hear Him? Is He calling you? Follow Him and you will . . . Be Blessed!

Spiritual transformation is something we all need on a daily basis. Yes, getting away from distractions for a week can help us hone in on what is important. But you don't even have to leave your home for God to radically get a hold of your life. His plans are far greater than any plans we can come up with on our own. God wants to mold you into His image. If He is your God then allow Him to have complete control.
