


Would you be willing to help a child recite their Bible Verse the first 10 minutes of Bible Skills Drills and Thrills?



From the Pastor's Desk

I love mornings like this one, when the Church gathers at the Lord's Table in obedience, as a time of remembrance and worship. Here at Believers, we always make the Lord's Supper the center of our worship gathering; music, Scripture readings, and prayers all direct us to this special time of worship! It's my conviction that celebrating the Lord's Supper should never be an "add-on" to our worship experience. It is a special time of worship that deserves to be the center of our attention as we worship. Today we will read from **Luke 22:14-20**, where Luke records the events that took place in the Upper Room where Jesus and His friends gathered to celebrate the Passover Feast by sharing together a meal filled with historical meaning and purpose. Jesus took an ancient symbol (Passover) and gave it new meaning as He called His friends to . . .

...Remember the historical significance. In Exodus 12, Israel was called to observe the feast of the unleavened bread (Passover) to celebrate the final step of God's miraculous delivery of His people from bondage. Those covered by the blood of the Lamb were given life. What God did for Isarel through the slaughter of many lambs was later given to all of humanity by shedding the blood of One Lamb (Jesus), and those covered by His blood are given life abundant and eternal. As we approach this time, we need to also be certain that we . . .

...Remember the redemptive significance of what Jesus has done! When John the Baptist saw Jesus approaching, he said "**Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!**" (John 1:29). In Exodus 12, a lamb would be sacrificed for each family, but God's Passover lamb was offered to pay for all mankind. The Passover lamb in Exodus was a substitute for the 1st born of the family; in Jesus, God's 1st born became our substitute. Jesus knew exactly why He was here and what He came to do; He "**came to seek and to save that which was lost**" (Luke 19:10). As we observe the Lord's Supper, we need also to . . .

...Remember the personal significance. Jesus told His friends, "**This is my body which is given for you...**" "**This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.**" (Luke 22:19-20). In the days to come, they would realize how personal this really was. Jesus would suffer for them, He would bleed for them, and He would die for them. It is still very personal. What Jesus did, He did for me and for you. It is for each of us! In 1st Corinthians 11 Paul reminded his friends of two very important truths. First, we need to be certain of our personal salvation when we come to participate at the Lord's Table, and 2nd, every time we gather for this remembrance we are also proclaiming our belief in the sufficiency of His sacrificial death as we await His return!

My point is simple; let's slow down this morning and allow this time of worship to roll over us and grant the Holy Spirit free access to move and fill us. This is a time for reverence, humility, sincerity, honesty, and understanding. Let's rejoice in His presence and allow Him to speak to our hearts and direct our lives, and when we depart, let's go serve as He leads. Do these things today and you will . . . Be Blessed!

If God's Word is not a regular part of your life, you should not be surprised when life is hard. You shouldn't be surprised when you're depressed, anxious, angry, addicted, directionless, lonely, bitter, or stagnant. We cannot keep claiming to be people of the Word and not have the Word be the guiding force in our life.

This is one of the reasons why we do Color Wars every year. We want to try to encourage habits that get students into the Word. And just maybe they will encourage their families to do the same.
