FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

As we return to John's Gospel this morning (John 1:35-42), I want you to see how Jesus changes a life. In this passage we read the first recorded words of the Master as He began His earthly ministry, *"What do you seek?"* (1:38). These words to Andrew and the unnamed disciple (most likely John) mark a beginning; from this time forward Jesus began calling and inviting people to follow Him, enter His Kingdom, and serve His purposes.

Nearly two thousand years have passed, and Jesus is still calling and inviting people to experience a life-altering relationship with Him. He also uses those who have chosen to follow Him, who have already begun walking with Him, to invite others to meet Him and discover what Jesus is really all about. His methods today are still the same. People who recognize Jesus point others toward Him, so they can discover Jesus also. Let's look at John's record and see how this pattern is revealed. We must begin by considering . . .

...The importance of recognizing Jesus (1:35-37). John the Baptist *"was standing with two of his disciples"* when Jesus approached again. For the 2nd time in two days, John identified Him as *"the Lamb of God"* as if to make sure his friends didn't miss the arrival of Jesus. When John revealed Jesus to them, they wasted no time! They left John, the crowds he was drawing, their other friends, and we don't even see that they stopped to gather their belongings – They left everyone and everything to pursue Jesus! In every life there comes a moment when we see the Truth and we must choose how we will respond! These two chose to risk it all, to discover what happens. . .

...When the WHO provides the WHAT (1:38-39). Jesus didn't ask them, "Who they were looking for." He asked, "What they were looking for." People often start out looking for something only to discover that what they are looking for is found in a person – we have to find the correct "WHO." They weren't sure what they were looking for but they were convinced it would be found with Jesus, so they asked where He was staying. We aren't told where it was, but they were invited to "Come and see" and their time with Jesus led them to become His disciples. From them, I believe we can learn that . . .

...Meeting the Master WILL CHANGE YOU! (1:40-42) Never underestimate *"the power of inviting."* Andrew went and found his brother Simon, told him he had found the Messiah, and invited him to meet Jesus. John shows us that Andrew was always bringing people to Jesus. His brother Simon became Simon Peter, a man who believed in and pursued Jesus. He was far from perfect, but he became an early leader for the church and a powerful evangelist. Others were brought, others met Jesus, and others experienced His power to change a life!

Perhaps you're looking for something today. Something that will change your direction, change your life, and change your reason for living. What you are looking for is Jesus, the Messiah, the Savior, the Giver of life; the One can make life make sense even in an upside-down world. Would you like to meet Him? We've found the Savior and like Andrew we can arrange an introduction for you today. You will find Him amazing as He invites you to follow Him Like Simon, pursue Him and you will . . . Be Blessed!
