From the Pastor's Desk

Today we're going to examine a confrontation from the final week of Jesus' ministry; His enemies were desperately trying to find cause to eliminate Jesus. They did everything in their power to get His followers to turn on Him or get Him to say or do something that would set the government after Him.

Jesus' actions, the words He spoke and the teachings He shared all served to infuriate His enemies until they were driven by desperation to take Him into custody. They were so desperate they would try anything! They tried to trick Him, and they tried to trap Him; yet He constantly stayed beyond their reach and outside their traps. In Luke 20:19-26, we see what happens when we follow our sinful desires and . . .

...How the human struggles against the Divine (20:19-20). It is always helpful for us to recognize what motivates people and as these words reveal – fear outweighs man's outrage! The religious leaders desperately wanted to get their hands on Jesus, but they were afraid of the people! Jesus knew they had hardened hearts and they proved it by sending **"spies who pretended to be righteous"** (20). These spies did everything they could think of to trap Jesus in some misdeed or to **"catch Him in some statement"** so they could turn Him over to the authorities. Today, hardened human hearts still struggle against the Divine. You may fool those around you into thinking everything is okay, but . . .

...You can never deceive the Master (20:21-23a). Words can be misused and misperceived, they can also be used to mislead people. Knowing this, the spies tried to pull Jesus in with flattery. They said to Jesus, **Teacher, we know that You speak and teach correctly, and You are not partial to any, but teach the way of God in truth** (21). They said the right things but not with the right intention! They knew their masters loved to be flattered and fawned over, so they tried this with Jesus before asking Him, **"Is it lawful for us to pay taxes to Caesar or not?"** (22) It was a good question, but Luke says, **"...He detected their trickery"** (23a) Jesus could see through their tactics! He heard their words and He saw their hearts and knew their motives. Jesus still sees hearts and motives today. He knows what's going on inside of us this morning. Why are you here? Did you come to worship? Or, are you . . .

...Worrying about the worldly while forgetting about the spiritual (20:23b-26). Lots of folks are stressed over politics and taxes today, just like they did then! These spies tried to divide Jesus' followers over politics and taxes by getting Him to say something carelessly. Would He betray His Jewishness by supporting Rome or would He incite insurrection against Rome by defending His Jewishness? Did you know you can serve the government and God at the same time? Your coins bear governmental images, but you bear the likeness of God! When these men realized they couldn't trap Jesus, they **"became silent"** (26) – they were rendered speechless!

Why did mankind miss Messiah? For the same reason people miss Him today! We see what we want to see, and we refuse to see and acknowledge what we do not want to see! I see Jesus, my Savior and Lord. What or whom do you see? Will you see Jesus? Will you hear Him calling? Come to Him, follow Him, and you will . . . Be Blessed!

There are a lot of opinions on what is best for kids and teenagers. What's the best diet, what's the best school, what's the best career path, what's the best college, what's the best parenting style, and so many more that it'll make your head spin. First off, no one has it all figured out. If they did, they would write a book and everyone would do it so that they too could have perfect little humans.

While there are a lot of things that can be good for your kids, research shows us that the best way to impact, influence, and teach your kids about anything is with a heart connection. Some of you who attended our Family Conference last year with Dr. Ross might remember this topic being discussed. What that means is that you must have a connection to the heart of your teen. Not just know them, their likes and dislikes, not just talk to them, but have a deep connection. This doesn't happen over night or even over a week of intentional effort. This is a continuous thing that we must work on.

We form heart connections by taking time to value, listen, invest, and love our children. This doesn't mean we're perfect, but it does mean that there is intentionality to it. Our children will connect their heart to someone, whether that is a parent, coach, or friend. A heart connection is more than just knowing someone. For example, if I discipline our 2-year-old it isn't long before she finds me again and wants to play. It's not because she enjoyed the discipline she received, but because a heart connection exists.

When you have that kind of connection with your child, then the things you pass on to them will pass straight into the heart and have a much higher chance of sticking.
