

From the Pastor's Pen

This morning we will gather around the Lord's Table to celebrate the Lord's Supper, in commemoration of what occurred in the Upper Room (in Jerusalem) on the evening before Jesus was betrayed. Some will wonder, "Why are we doing this on the Sunday following Easter?" and that is a good question! Can you imagine what those first disciples were feeling and thinking when they gathered the week after the resurrection?

John's gospel tells us (Jn. 20:26) that they came together again the next week behind closed doors when the risen Lord appeared to them again (this was the appearance at which the faith of Thomas was confirmed!). I wonder what they were thinking about. Were they recalling the events from the week before? What were their thoughts on that day?

As we come together this morning, the celebration of the resurrection is fresh in our minds, but I want us to think back to Calvary – the place of the cross. I've been asked before, "Preacher, why do you talk so much and so often about the cross?" Well, if we don't talk about the cross, we tend to forget the price that was paid to redeem us from sin and restore us to God. So, before we observe the Lord's Supper, let's make an imaginary trip to Calvary and consider what we need to remember as we consider our Lord's sacrifice on the cross. I need to see Calvary . . .

...To discover (or re-discover) my sinfulness. Our natural tendency to ignore, conceal, excuse, or explain away our sin. Standing at Calvary and seeing Jesus bear the guilt, the shame, and the penalty of my sin, I find it difficult, almost impossible not to confess and forsake my sin. When I observe His innocence as compared to the guilt I carry, it's an awful reminder that He suffered in my place, for my sin. I need to see the events on Calvary . . .

...To discover the nature of my God. Most world religions portray their gods as possessing human vices. Calvary shows how different God is from us; it reveals His grace and mercy toward sinners. It was on Calvary that Christ Jesus redeemed me from the penalty of sin. It was redemption by love as He suffered in my place. I must visit Calvary . . .

...To discover the world's only hope of salvation. Many people have chosen to worship wealth, power, politics, education, or science. There have been many individuals who have claimed to be messiah or god, but there is just one hope! Only Jesus can make one a new creation and give a new life. My friends, it's when I visit Calvary that . . .

...I find inspiration for service. The elements of the Lord's Supper remind me of how freely and completely Jesus gave Himself for me. He was dedicated to the Father's will, and I am called to follow His example. We are called to make Him known to all the world.

I pray that this morning you will join me at Calvary, remembering the sacrifice made, the price paid, the love revealed, an invitation extended. Have you accepted His invitation to come and follow? If so, praise Him! If not, hear His call, come follow Him and you will . . . Be Blessed!
