The van will be leaving BSBC church at 10:30 AM returning around 4:00 PM. Bring a back pack for your tracts and be ready to tell people about our soon coming King!

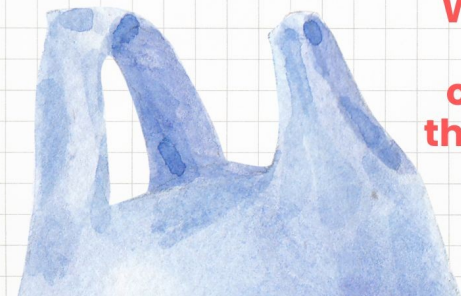
For those driving to the event it will be located at 21<sup>st</sup> & North Broadway.

## From the Pastor's Pen

Too often, we believers allow something that has gained our attention to turn our focus onto lesser things. It is so easy to give our resources, energy, and time to things to important things that are still less than the main thing! Lesser things may be good and worth taking note of, but they should never replace the main thing because . . . they are lesser!

In John 3 we read about Nicodemus coming to Jesus. He was a good man, but his life was filled with all manner of lesser things and he knew it! Something was missing so he came to Jesus seeking answers. Most of those who were drawn to Jesus were common people but not Nicodemus. He was what we would refer to as an aristocrat, he would have been listed in the "Who's Who Among Jewish Leaders." He was kind of a big deal and was well known and easily recognized in Jerusalem.

I'm not sure how John overheard or learned about this conversation, but I am glad he gave us this record. We are privileged to listen in on the meeting and hear about the one thing that really matters. It seems strange that this educated, esteemed religious leader came to seek answers from an itinerant rabbi. After all . . .

**...Nicodemus was a religious man** whom John called "**a man of the Pharisees.**" He knew the law and all the rules and followed them carefully. He was a public leader in the synagogue and frequented the Temple; he fasted, prayed, tithed, and offered sacrifices. He was a highly religious man who knew there had to be something more! Perhaps we should consider that . . .

**...Nicodemus was very sincere and orthodox** in practicing his religion! He was confused but did not approach Jesus in self-righteous arrogance; he came humbly seeking an answer and Jesus told him "**you must be born again.**" He was orthodox in his practices, he followed the rules and obeyed the law but orthodoxy is not enough! He was sincere, he longed with all of his heart to be right with God; but sincerity is not enough (you can be sincerely WRONG!). No matter how orthodox or sincere you might be it still is true that "**you must be born again.**" If you examined his life, you would see that . . .

**...Nicodemus was everything society would accept!** He was a man of high moral character; intelligent, well-spoken, highly respected, and of unquestioned integrity. He was cultured, wealthy, powerful, and positioned. Nicodemus had gone as far in society as his human attributes and efforts would allow but he knew in his heart that something was still missing! There had to be something more so he sought out Jesus because he knew Jesus was different from everyone else! Jesus spoke the truth to him saying "**you must be born again.**" This is a miracle of God's doing as His Spirit calls, convicts, and changes one into a new creation. His working is like the wind blowing – we can't see it, but we can see the effect it produces! (8)

HEAR ME WELL ... religion is not the answer and everything the world praises is not the answer! Being "born again" into a personal, spiritual relationship with Jesus that brings healing, forgiveness, and life . . . that is the answer! Listen for His voice today, hear His call, follow Him and you will . . . Be Blessed!

If your teenager is longing for purpose. Longing for meaning. Longing for a change. Longing for hope in their life again, then you need to make sure they come to camp this year. Camp is not just a fun thing we go to (although it is fun), it is a place we go to see lives moved and transformed into something new by the One who created your child. It's not that God only speaks at camp, but when we get away from all of life's distractions, the voice of God becomes a lot more clear.
