From the Pastor's Desk

Two weeks ago, we met Nicodemus who came to Jesus (John 3) trying to understand God's kingdom. He appeared again (John 7), to defend Jesus when He came under one of many attacks from the religious leaders of the Jews.

Now we arrive at the culmination of this continual back-and-forth between Jesus and the Jewish religious leaders. They had Jesus arrested and placed in the hands of Pilate, the Roman authority in that region and in John 19 we read about the day humanity judged itself!

I invite you to remember that on that day, there were those nearby who loved Jesus, knew who He was, and were committed to following Him. There were spectators who had not decided yet and wanted to see how this would end. Certainly, some had hardened their hearts and would not be changed no matter what they saw or heard; they had rejected Jesus and would never be swayed. Inside this very room today, the very same categories exist and each of us is in one of these groups. If you examine the gospels, you will see . . .

A cowardly controller and his cohort. It seems that Pilate was a coward; he was in charge but had others to do all the dirty work for him. He was responsible for the scourging, beating, and humiliation of Jesus. He was afraid of the crowd, afraid of Jesus, and afraid of what might be reported back to Rome. He wanted to do the right thing but was uncertain of what the right thing was, so he decided to do nothing and let others assume responsibility. He surrendered to . . .

Those who have set their course! These were the Jewish religious leaders; the chief priests and Pharisees, who were driven by hard, unfeeling hearts. These men were over-inflated with their sense of self importance when they had little authority at all. They pressured Pilate, knowing that at some point, we all choose where our loyalty will lie. They wanted what they wanted so badly that when Pilate offered up Jesus as their king, they stated "We have no king but Caesar" (19:15). With those words, they made their choice and were . . .

Pronouncing their own judgment. People judge themselves anytime they choose anything or anyone over God! Perhaps they were choosing to eliminate the threat they saw to their power and control over their society. They chose and stated their loyalty to Caesar and Rome instead of God and His Son. You see, God has created us with free will (to make choices), and in His goodness, God provided us the option of life and grace in Jesus Christ. So, God is not at fault when we choose another way!

Don't be a coward. You can't avoid this decision and like Pilate you cannot allow someone else to make it for you! You will decide. Don't harden your heart and set your course. Once you do, you will worship other things and become an enemy of God! Allow the Spirit of God to soften your heart today. Do not judge yourself today! Realize that in turning your back on God and on Christ you will condemn yourself and will most likely condemn your children as well! For God's sake and your family's sake, turn from your sin and step into the Light today!

Today, hear His voice, turn to Him, and follow Him. It may not always be easy, but you will . . . Be Blessed!


