



TAKEAWAYS

February 4, 2018

A relationship involving two sinners is going to have conflict. Because of that, relationships provide the opportunity for us to show real gospel fruit in our lives.

Sinful people tend to respond sinfully when sinned against.

The Romans Road explains the good news of salvation using verses from the Book of Romans. Click on <https://www.gotquestions.org/Romans-road-salvation.html>

We need to rethink our reaction to conflict.

Romans 12:18, "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone." I can't determine how someone else will react in a given situation, but I can do my part, not take offense, and walk in love toward those who have hurt me.

Our default response to conflict usually falls in one of two categories: escape or attack.

People who choose to escape are more interested in avoiding than resolving conflict.

People who choose to attack are more interested in winning than preserving the relationship.

We may respond differently depending on the setting (home, work, etc.). Our true default is demonstrated to those who are closest to us...those we love most.

We need to replace our natural response, and the Bible offers a way to do that.

In any conflict, make it your goal, your priority, to please God. II Corinthians 5:9, "So we make it our goal to please him."

Techniques without transformation are nothing more than sin management. Jesus doesn't want you to manage sin; He wants you to remove sin from your life, to transform sinful responses into godly responses.

ACTION STEPS

Determine your default response to conflict. If you are unsure, ask those who are closest to you.

Ask yourself, "What do I need to do in this conflict to please God?"

Read James 4:1-3 in preparation for this week's sermon.

This was first trip in our three-year missions strategy to the Dominican Republic. We ministered in Santiago, La Romana, San Juan and Santo Domingo. There were just under 1,000 Dominican's trained, the majority of which were pastors who will be training their churches over next two weeks. The last week of February is national thrust of going house-to-house sharing Christ. On this trip, 543 individuals prayed to receive Christ and there were thousands of faith conversations!


