1. God's Will for everyone is to believe in Jesus Christ as the Son of God and be saved from their sins.

John 6:40 (NIV)

2. God's will for every Christ follower is summarized in the great commandment and the great commission.

3. God's will is that every Christ follower serves God and others as a Priest.

The Supernatural Option... God can make a super-natural revelation to you to you in order to make His will known.

This a “Theophany”. A temporary visible manifestation of the presence and glory of God. This may be in natural phenomena such as cloud or fire, in human form or in prophetic visionary experience.

God can manifest in human form (Exodus 24:10), in visions or dreams (Numbers 24:3-4; Isaiah 6; Ezekiel 1; Daniel 7, Acts 10), as the “Angel of the Lord” (Genesis 16, 22; Judges 6; Zechariah 1; Matthew 1,2; Luke 1,2) or supernatural manifestation of nature like a burning bush that speaks to Moses or a pillar of fire at night that leads the Israelite people or a blinding light and voice to call Saul to salvation. While these are most uncommon, they are certainly within the realm of God’s working.

There is never a super natural manifestation that is contrary to the written Word of God!
