Expressing Christ's Compassion Doing Justice

Covenant's History of Activism

- 1947 - opened first integrated preschool in Cleveland
- 1951 - integrated Covenant worshipping community
- 1960 - fought for desegregation of Cleveland schools
- 1976 - opened Cache resale shop
- 1990 - started Saturday tutoring program
- 2006 - created Interfaith Center for Catholic, Muslim, and Protestant student organizations
- 2010 - supported ordination of LGBT individuals
- 2010 - created Covenant University and Community ministries, a 501(c)3 umbrella for Covenant and community outreach programs



Covenant continues the tradition of social justice, advocacy, and outreach, partnering with over 20 local and global organizations. Abington Arms, Daniel E. Morgan school, Dougbe River Presbyterian School in Liberia, and Family Promise of Greater Cleveland are among our partners.
