Budget report:

Income for 2017:

Deacons - \$1,500 Hospitality - \$4,500 Gift from Trustees - \$579.79

(This is a one-time gift; it is the remaining money from a fund that Chuck Langmack used to provide the monthly member breakfasts.)

Expenses for December 2016:

• Gifts for Shut-ins - \$184

Many thanks were given to Norma Shuskey for organizing and providing the supplies, including cutting the many circles of cloth.

Gifts to Cleveland School of the Arts (CSA) - \$305

Many thanks were given to Marjie Hines for organizing and delivering gifts in red backpacks/ bags. Seventy-five (75) bags were given to CSA. Renee, from CSA, reported that gifts were greatly appreciated by the students! CSA determined students who were most in need and were recipients of the gifts.

DISCUSSION: 2017 Christmas gifts/ Giving Tree organizations (replacing Goodrich Gannett): Melanie Baum conveyed that Benjamin Rose would be excited to work with us on gifts for their seniors. Matthew Garrett suggested that we explore other groups at CSA in an effort to continue the relationship with the school. People wondered, and it will be explored, if there is a possibility of having two trees, one for each group.

Memorial Service Receptions

Ed Laylin found a replacement for \$279. Melanie talked with the trustees who indicated that Deacons could purchase this. The money for the refrigerator will be used from the \$579.79 one-time grant. Ed and Melanie will work with Willie Howard on the purchase and installation.

- Easter Breakfast helping with set up, serving and clean-up
