

About Harvest Wednesdays

Jesus calls us to teach people to obey everything he commanded (Matthew 28:19-20). Harvest Wednesdays include a series of 18 classes that equip adults (ages 18+) to do this.

These classes complement our other ministries by generally being:

- ⇒ more instructional than our small groups.
- ⇒ more topic- and skills-focused than our Sunday morning preaching ministry.

Core Values — Classes are designed to be:

1. Relational—interaction and relationships are essential to spiritual growth.
2. Equipping—conveying both truth and skills.
3. Practical—the emphasis is on living out what we learn.

How it Works:

Adult classes are offered during three sessions each year: fall, winter and spring. Classes fall into one of three main categories:

- **Essentials**—knowledge and skills every Christian needs to live for Jesus.
- **Bible and Theology**—the framework for understanding everything in the Bible.
- **Christian Living**—guidance and skills for managing our money, relationships, time, etc., biblically.




