One: God hear our prayer, when the world feels like it is falling apart, when crisis looms around every corner and our bodies carry more tension than we can name.

One: In the beginning, God rested, on the seventh day, God paused and called it holy. Jesus slept in the storm-tossed boat. Jesus slipped away from the crowds to pray.

All: So we come, releasing the clench in our jaw, the tightness in our shoulders, the swirl of thoughts that will not quiet. Let this be a Sabbath moment.
