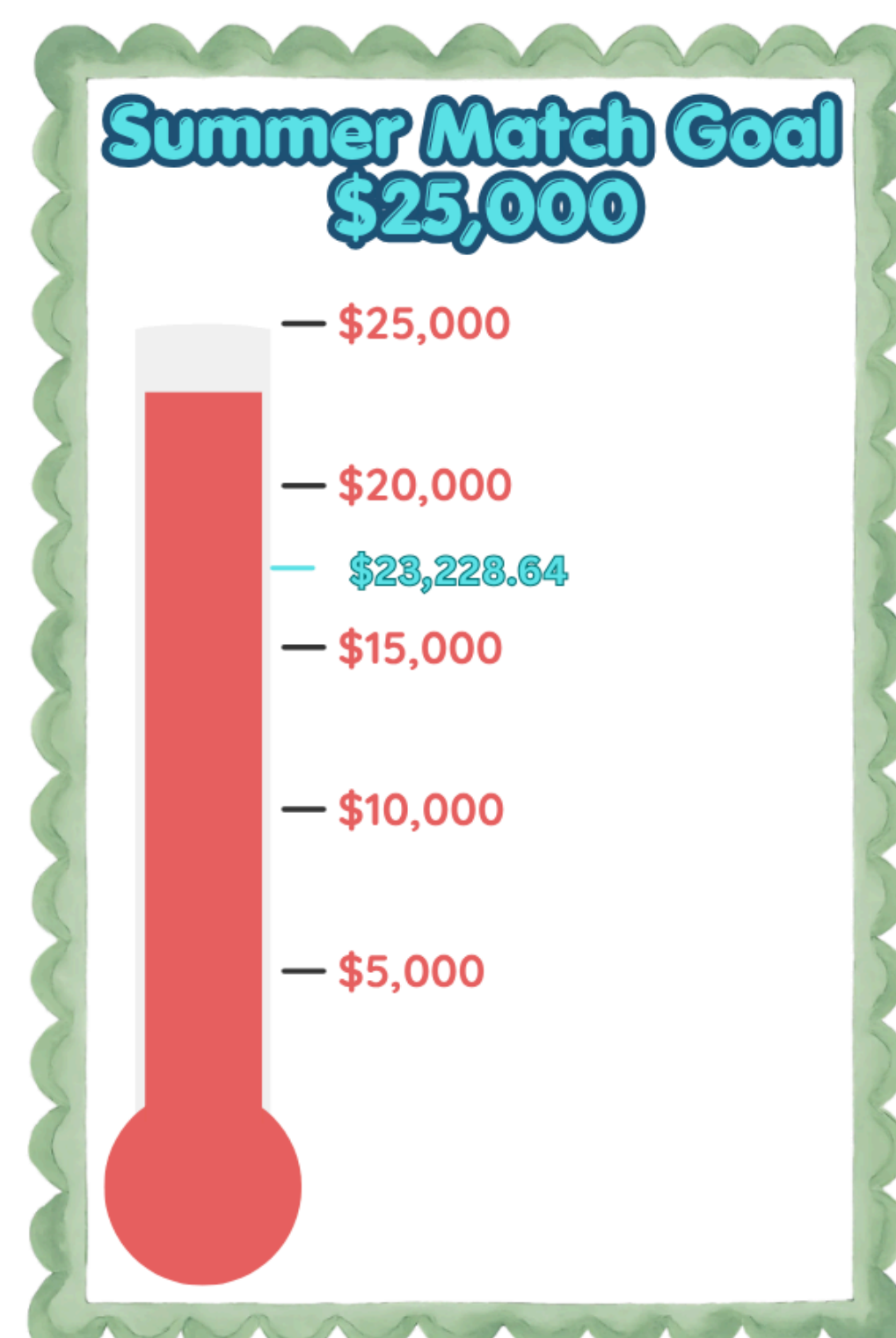

One: The psalmist cries out,
