Instead, you will use an "Alt ID" online and at checkout in stores. If you already have a Dillon's Plus card go to www.dillons.com to sign in.

- Once you've signed in to your Dillon's account, you can enroll in community rewards. Try following these simple instructions below:
- o On the upper right side of the screen, click under your name for the drop-down menu.
- o Click on "My Account."
- o From the left side menu, click on "Community Rewards."
