On Thursday evening, August 7, 6:00 pm at City Hall, Mary Dean will deliver a proposal to Mayor Lily Wu and Wichita city council formally requesting that the city establish a reparations commission to address historic discrimination including redlining, environmental racism, loss of property, health disparities, financial discrimination and other harms caused to Black Wichitans. Mary invites CHUM members to join her in solidarity as she speaks. Members of CHUM youth will offer their own testimonies supporting Mary's proposal. If you do not already have a Dillons Plus card, you can sign up for one at www.dillons.com/account/create. *When you request a Digital Plus Shopper's card online, you will not receive a physical card. Instead, you will use an "Alt ID" online and at checkout in stores.*

If you already have a Dillon's Plus card go to www.dillons.com to sign in.

- Once you've signed in to your Dillon's account, you can enroll in community rewards. Try following these simple instructions below:
 - On the upper right side of the screen, click under your name for the drop-down menu.
 - Click on "My Account."
 - From the left side menu, click on "Community Rewards."
 - Use code **PG779** to choose College Hill United Methodist Church as your rewards recipient.
 - Click to select it and you are finished!
