CONGREGATIONAL CARE MINISTRY

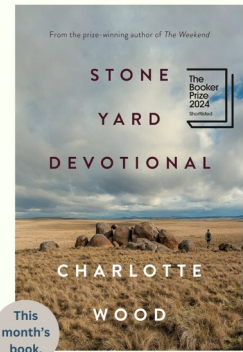

Our congregation is part of a county-wide ministry called Justice Together. Yearly, we identify where people are suffering in our community and research solutions. We build networks that mobilize over 1,200 people of faith for a great annual assembly for justice where local officials commit to enact researched, community driven proposals.

Our organized people power delivers real results.

Here's what we've won for our community:

1. A no-cost, low barrier municipal ID in Wichita for people experiencing homelessness to access jobs, housing, and services.
2. Millions of dollars investment by City of Wichita, including ongoing funding for the operations at the multi-agency center now known as Second Light whose mission is to deliver wrap around homeless support services and permanent affordable housing placement.
3. 24 hour mobile mental crisis units at COMCARE so that those struggling with mental health can stabilize in place, instead of the ER or jail.

Last year, at the 2025 Nehemiah Assembly, three members of the Wichita City Council committed to working with Justice Together to fund \$10 million annually to an improved existing Affordable Housing fund to help address the high number of people who are spending 30% or more of their income on housing and the multi-year backlog of people waiting for Section 8 placement.

Join us for the Justice Together Community Problems Assembly where we will hear updates on our past issue work, vote on our top priority that will be the focus of our justice work this year, and announce next steps we will take together!
