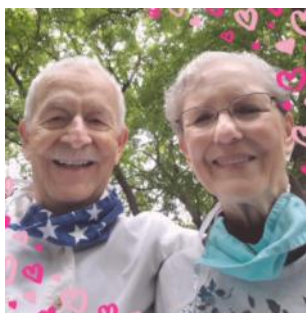

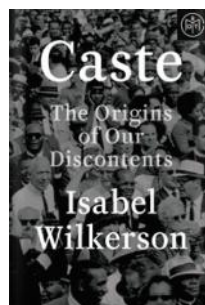

## Tech Tips for Online Worship

### Website

You can find the 9:00 am or 10:15 am service by going to our website: <http://collegehillumc.org/worship/live-stream>

- **Trouble: Buffering**
- **Tips:** Refresh your browser or restart your computer. If you still have trouble, check into your home internet speed. You may need a higher speed in order to stream the service.
- **Trouble: Service is interrupted with the welcome video**
- **Tips:** This means that we have a problem on our end and we need to stop and restart the livestream. Be patient. We are working as fast as we can to fix the problem! Refresh your browser every few minutes. The service will start again when we finish troubleshooting!

### Facebook

You can also watch the 9:00 am or the 10:15 am service by logging into Facebook

<https://www.facebook.com/CollegeHillUMC/> About a month ago, Facebook changed their streaming guidelines and we were blocked from streaming. So, we switched to using a different Facebook feature called Premiere. All this means is that we have recorded the worship service earlier in the week and are publishing it on Sunday mornings so that YOU can join us for worship via Facebook.

- **Trouble: Can't find the service**
- **Tips:** When we schedule the Premiere, there will be an announcement about it which you can find on your timeline or on the CHUM Facebook page late in the week. Click on "Get Reminder" and you will receive a notification on Sunday when the service begins.
- **Tips:** Another way to find the service is by going to our CHUM Facebook page before the service begins. You will see the Premiere announcement with a 3 minute countdown. Click on it and you'll see the service as soon as it begins.
